



Teachers' notes for extension activities

There are many opportunities to develop learning linked to Bamburgh Bones and this section of the learning resource contains a couple of suggestions:

- **Story writing**

We have provided a set of the illustrations of the seven skeletons you studied in the lessons.

The illustrations can be used as stimulus to write about the lives of the people who lived at the royal court at Bamburgh. You might want to use these after lessons 3 or 5.

You might also use the image of Oferbraedan (image is of a man with a book) as stimulus to write about the journey of St Aidan and the possibility that this man travelled with him (lesson 6)

- **Spirit in Stone exploring churches digital RE resource**

This digital resource was created for Inspired North East, part of the Diocese of Newcastle. Physical copies of the resource were sent to every school in the North East and North Yorkshire, but you can also download it for free. The resource encourages schools to use churches to support teaching RE and provides materials for each Key Stage. In KS2 one section explores the northern saints and provides valuable resources to support the Bamburgh Bones learning materials.
